


Family Team Meeting



CPS INVESTIGATION *Assigned to Case worker *Meet with family *Staff with CPS lead *Staff with District Attorney *File Petition *Notify Family Group Conference

(PIR or Control Group)

INTRODUCTION TO PARENTING IN RECOVERY and Drug Court *FTM in 1-5 days

*Family decides yes or no to PIR/Drug Court *Family to sign PIR waivers

*Treatment can begin anytime at this point *FTM makes referral to Kinship Program



FILE PETITION *Family-based safety services


Conservatorship EX PARTE HEARING *Drug Court Parent Attorney

*Parent signs Drug Court document

Enter treatment within 1st 10 days

AUSTIN RECOVERY *Women and child(ren) in treatment for 90 days.

*Drug Court to begin within first 30 days of treatment.



262 or 153 **Court Hearing** within 14 days



*Conservatorship

*Kinship placement or

with parent in treatment

(children may be placed in foster

care)

CPS case transfers to either: *Family-Based Safety Services

FAMILY GROUP CONFERENCES Collaborative Case Planning *Location - Austin Recovery *First FGC within 30 days *Future FGC dates determined by CPS Caseworker


Transport to housing after 90 days in Austin Recovery.



Foundation Community Housing

Alternative Housing Option

*9 months of paid housing *Case Manager *Transportation to drug court *4-6 weeks outpatient treatment *8 weeks aftercare *wrap services as needed



*CPS, FC, PIR assist client in securing housing *PIR grant will provide funding for non-FC housing when needed *4-6 weeks outpatient treatment *8 weeks aftercare *wrap services as needed
