

## **QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE TO CASE CONFERENCE NOTES**

**Placement Dimension Ratings-** Based on the American Society of Addiction Medicine Patient Placement Criteria For The Treatment of Substance Related.

Disorders And Edition-Revised (ASAM), across 6 dimensions:

Dimension 1-Acute intoxication/Withdrawal

Dimension 2- Biomedical Conditions/Complications

Dimension 3- Emotional Behavioral Conditions/Complications

Dimension 4- Treatment Acceptance/Readiness for Change

Dimension 5- Relapse Potential

Dimension 6- Recovery Environment

**ASAM Level I=Outpatient Treatment (OP)**, Outpatient counseling services 1-8 hours per week.

**ASAM Level II= Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOP)**, Outpatient counseling services 9-15 hours per week.

**ASAM Level II.I= Partial care or Partial Hospitalization Treatment (PC or PH)**, Outpatient counseling services 16-30 hours per week.

**ASAM Level III= Residential Intensive Inpatient Treatment III.I** Halfway House-House long term 8-12 months, **III.5-** Therapeutic community-long term 12-18 months, **III.7-** Short tem medically managed residential treatment usually between 10-28 days.

**Detoxification Levels of Care;** **ASAM Level ID-**Outpatient ambulatory detox plus counseling up to 8 hours per week, **IID-**Outpatient ambulatory detox plus counseling up to 25 hours counseling/supervision per week, **III.7D-**Residential medically monitored intensive inpatient treatment, **IV-** Medically managed hospital based intensive inpatient treatment.

**OMT** -Opioid Maintenance Therapy, typically refers to methadone maintenance treatment.
