The benefits of family involvement\*:

- Participation by family members is associated with better treatment compliance and outcomes.
  - Family members gain a clearer understanding of recovery
- Family members and the person in recovery understand their respective roles and goals
- Family members and the person in recovery get support in the recovery process

- Extended family
- Friends
- Colleagues from work
- Mentors
- Anyone who will support recovery

- Trauma-informed services
